The course rating is 73.0, and the slope is 128. Hosts all Lake Charles' City Championships, including the annual Summer Shoot-Out Series. It's a must play course if you are in Lake Charles, and the price is excellent!

The 18-hole, par-72 public course, designed by David Bennett, is set in a mature growth pine forest, featuring an abundance of water hazards, preserved wetlands, roughly 90 bunkers and is part of a high-end, residential community. There are five sets of tees with yardage ranging from 6,065 to 7,025 yards. Open daily, and tee times accepted 14 days in advance.
