Few destinations rival the ambience, architectural variety, heritage and sheer volume of golf courses as found in the scenic North Carolina Sandhills, with Pinehurst, Southern Pines and Aberdeen offering upwards of 40 layouts for players of all ages and handicaps.

Towering pines, dogwoods, magnolias, azaleas and native wire grasses dotted across sandy soil accentuate many of the area's courses designed by some of the game's great architects, such as Donald Ross, Tom Fazio, Ellis Maples, Dan Maples, Jack Nicklaus and Arnold Palmer.





ACCOLADES FOR OUR GREENS

Ten of the state's best 30 golf courses as ranked by the North Carolina Golf Panel are located here, with Pinehurst Resort's No. 2 course topping the list, and 23 area courses are ranked four stars or better by *Golf Digest*.

The iconic **Pinehurst Resort**, with its nine courses and historic golf memorabilia, is regarded as a world-class golfing bucket list play, and is the only club in the nation to have hosted the U.S. Open, U.S. Women's Open, U.S. Senior Open, U.S. Amateur and U.S. Women's Amateur.

The **U.S. Amateur (2019)** and **U.S. Open (2024)** are on the horizon again for Pinehurst, and the resort unveiled its new short course, The Cradle, in 2017. Designed by award-winning architect Gil Hanse, the course has nine holes ranging in distances from 65 to 117 yards and features many of the elements players face on the restored Pinehurst No. 2 course.

“For about a year I tried to put myself into the head of Donald Ross as we worked on the recent renovations at Pine Needles,” said course designer Kyle Franz of KMF Golf Course Design. “The result is a course that is both more fun and playable for the average golfer and more challenging for the professional.”



The **U.S. Kids World Championship** will also be staged in the Pinehurst area for the 13th straight year in August 2018 — attracting players from as far away as China, Japan and Korea, — and the **2019 U.S. Senior Women's Open** will be played at **Pine Needles Lodge and Golf Club** in Southern Pines.

What brings hundreds of thousands of eager golfers year after year? They come because they know they can enjoy round after round, day after day of play. And that's what it is all about! The area boasts 32 percent of the top 50 courses you can play in North Carolina, and a temperate climate that allows for play year-round — while experiencing an array of colors and contrasting landscapes.

A GOLF HISTORY LESSON

There is plenty of golf history on hand to absorb before or after your round. Did you know the first driving range was founded at Pinehurst Resort in 1910? The **Tufts Archives** in the heart of the Village of Pinehurst houses rare local and national golf information and displays.

In addition, the **Veteran Golfers Association** was created in 2014 and is located in Southern Pines — the first golfing organization dedicated to promoting the game to all veterans and their family members. While women's golfing legend Peggy Kirk Bell passed away in November 2016, her Golfari schools live on at Pine Needles Resort with their combination of learning, playing and relaxing in a unique golfing atmosphere.

The **Carolinas Golf Association** is located in Southern Pines, and its **Carolinas Golf Hall of Fame** selections are displayed in the Carolina Hotel of Pinehurst Resort.

When you swing your club at Mid Pines, you'll be swinging in the shadows of the iconic Julius Boros, two-time U.S. Open winner. Boros passed away in 1994, but his presence is still felt.



WHAT'S NEW AT LONGLEAF?

In 2015, the U.S. Kids Golf Foundation purchased Longleaf Golf and Country Club with a mission to bring more children and families into the game. They renamed the property the Longleaf Golf & Family Club. Improvements include a state-of-the-art practice facility and a 10,000-square-foot putting green with a nine-hole putting course. Longleaf is now home to the first U.S. Kids Golf Academy.

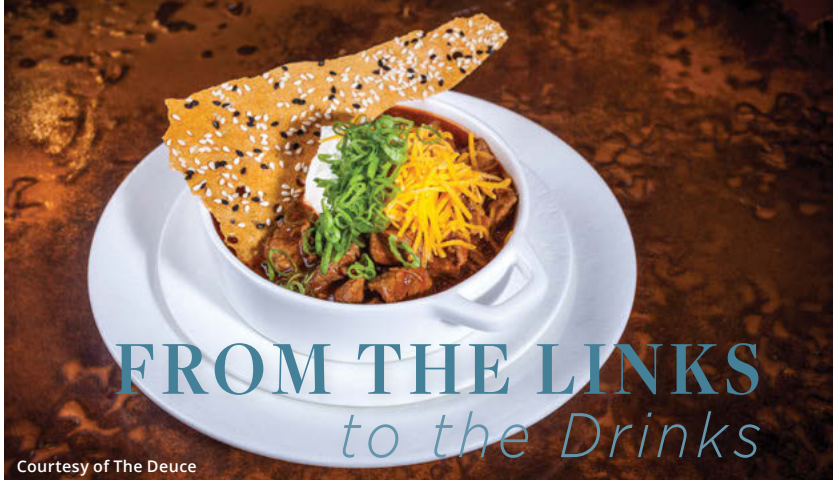

After a round of golf with family or friends, experience one of the area's eclectic 19th holes for some local flavor and ambiance, along with cold beverages and unique eats.

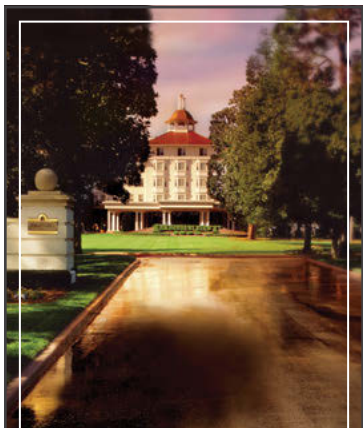
One of the newest award-winning hot spots is **The Deuce**, overlooking the 18th hole on Pinehurst No. 2, which has been turned into a trendy locale in the resort clubhouse for prime rib chili, colossal wings and a front-row seat to golfers finishing on the green Payne Stewart made famous in 1999. The Deuce was honored by *Golf Inc.* magazine and its annual Golden Fork Award with first place among new restaurants in all of golf.

The Sandhills also offers some of North Carolina's best cozy English-style pubs, where you can sink your teeth into juicy

burgers or break open some crispy fish 'n' chips. Favorites here are **Dugan's Pub** and **Squire's Pub**.

Wedgies in Southern Pines is home to the Original Pizza Crust Sandwich. If you're lucky, you'll catch owner Joe Gay, the former director of golf at Tobacco Road Golf Club, behind the grill and willing to share some links conversation. And be sure to swing by **Double Eagle Grill & Bar** in Aberdeen for a gourmet burger.

Local breweries have also been making headlines, with a wide selection of seasonal brews being poured at **Railhouse Brewery & Pub** in Aberdeen and **Southern Pines Brewing Co.**

MUST EATS

1 All-you-can-eat fish 'n' chips at Dugan's Pub. Owner and London native Alan Riley has been serving up the Bass beer-battered cod feast every Monday for 19 years. "Some say we've got the best fish and chips in the Southeast," Riley says. "It's something I cooked as a child and never thought it would translate into my adult years — and here it is almost two decades later."

2 In Southern Pines, plot your culinary course for The Squire's Pub. You won't leave hungry, with hearty dishes like Shepherd's Pie, Bangers and Mash, and unique burgers like the Grilled Duck and Grilled Lamb. And you won't leave thirsty either with their robust selection of English, Irish and Scottish beers. Be sure to ask about the daily beer special.

3 Try the challenge of Pine Crest Inn's beyond-generous 22-ounce porterhouse pork chop, a dish created by former chef Carl Jackson, who worked at the Inn for 61 years. Jackson has since passed away, but the chop remains a savory staple. "You don't even need a knife to cut it," said Drew Gross, the Inn's resident manager. "People come from all around; even if they are not staying here, they've heard about the pork chop."

4 The Pik-N-Pig's BBQ has been an area staple for four decades and sits adjacent to Gilliam-McConnell Airfield. Pig out and watch the planes land at this Carthage landmark. The newest addition to the menu — the BBQ Sundae — is an old favorite. "We've been serving these at the State Fair for years and now you don't have to wait until October," the owners say. Layered in a jar, the sundae consists of pulled pork, baked beans and a cole slaw topping.

5 Discover the unique spices and tastes of 195 – American Fusion Cuisine. This trendy eatery features chef Prem Nath, voted one of America's Best Chefs in 2017. The Southern Pines location changes its menu monthly and sources its vegetables locally from C.V. Pilson Farms in Cameron. A popular staple is Nath's Indian curry chicken with organic basmati rice.

6 For a celebration of all things steak, look no further than Beefeaters. They live up to the name with a proud array of ribeyes, filets, strips and porterhouse cuts. If a sandwich or burger is more your pace, head to the lounge side and order a generous French Dip or a Blue Cheese Burger. Rumor has it they also serve chicken and seafood.

7 A recommendation for Ironwood Café is more like three recommendations in one. Located in Pinehurst, Ironwood offers a laidback atmosphere at their bar, which includes plenty of TVs for catching up on the latest golf news. But they also have a modern dining room and a wonderful outdoor patio to give you three distinct choices. No matter where you sit, order a Smokin' Peach cocktail and pair it with their Baja Salmon Tacos.

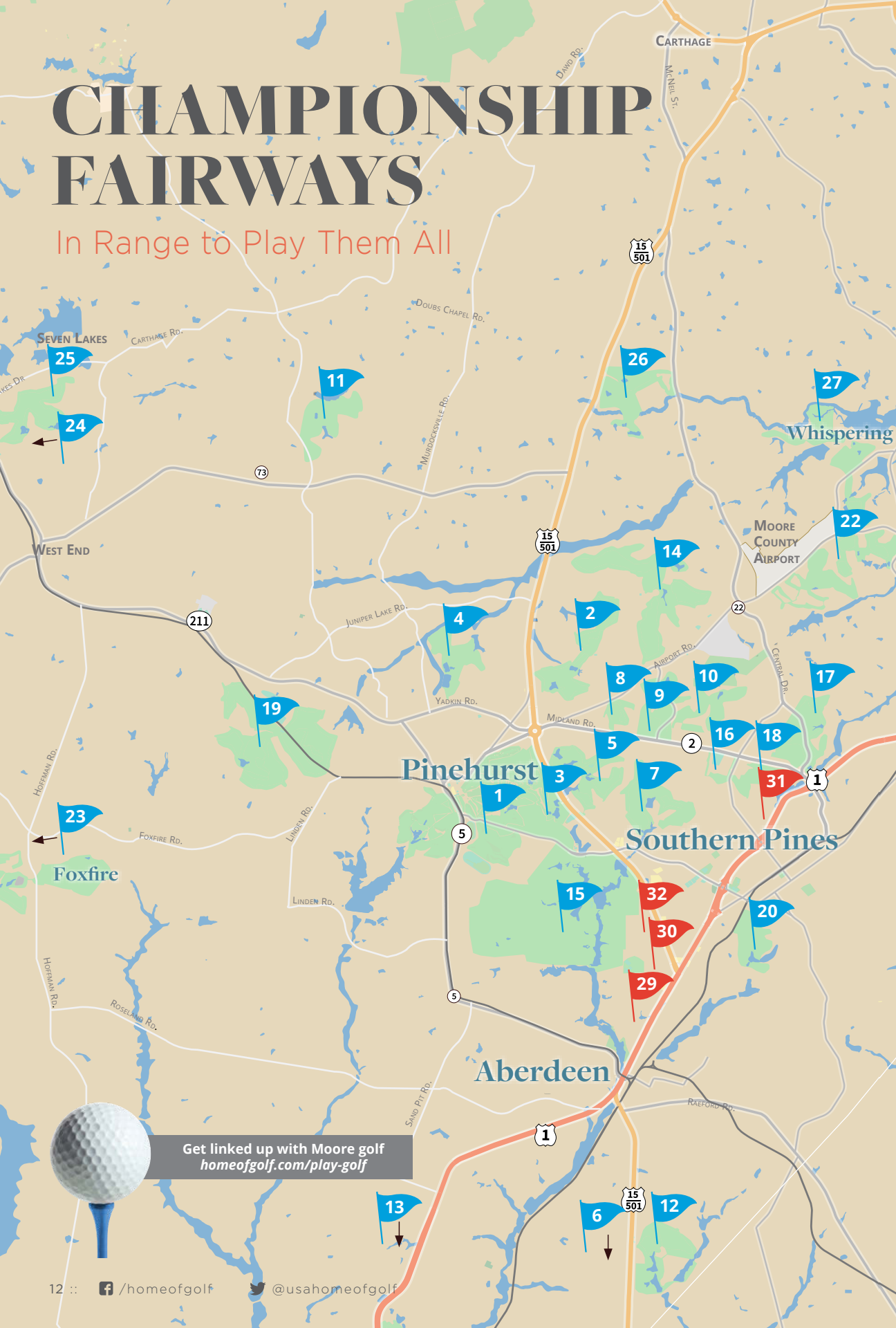

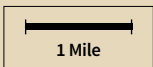

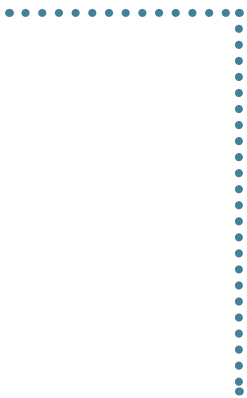

FIRED UP

& FABULOUS

The tradition of forming North Carolina's deep orange clay into usable forms has existed for hundreds of years, first with Native Americans crafting pots and ceremonial vessels as early as the 1500s, and later with European settlers who had no access to imported ceramics. These folk potters used local clay to shape pots, bowls and mugs, glazed their pieces with lead, wood ash or salt, and fired them in wooden kilns. Today, this style of earthenware pottery is some of the most sought after in the world.



DEEPLY ROOTED TRADITIONS

Potters in Moore County hold fast to these deeply rooted traditions, making each individual piece a true work of art. This attention to detail has made central North Carolina a true pottery destination and provides endless options for shopping, demonstrations and hands-on classes.

BUSBEE ROAD BOUNTY

If the idea of creating your own pottery trail feels a little daunting, take comfort in the fact that area potters stick together. For example, take the tight-knit art community of **Busbee Road**. Eleven shops displaying a wide range of pottery as well as handmade crafts and jewelry are laid out perfectly for you along three short miles.

LOCAL TALENT

Visit **Jugtown Pottery** for pieces made in the tried-and-true North Carolina tradition, **Linda Dalton Pottery** in West End for stunning pieces or **Raven Pottery & Craft Gallery** in Southern Pines for unique, handcrafted works of art from Anne Raven Jorgensen as well as many other talented area artists.

When you set out to discover Moore County, you are walking in the steps of history that began as far back as the sixth century with the Indians of the Siouan family. Their early migration trail later became known as the Yadkin Road, a route used by early settlers in the mid-1700s.



EUROPEAN SETTLERS

When the early European settlers came into Moore County around 1739, they chose the fertile grounds along the Deep River to start their new lives. By the mid-1750s the immigrants were coming mainly from the Scottish Highlands. This group settled predominantly in the Sandhills area, a region that had been bypassed before because of the poor soil. The Highland Scots proved to be hard-working and industrious as they made good use of what the land did provide — towering pines.

PINES TO SHIPS TO RAIL

The versatile pine tree led to the naval stores industry. The British Navy paid a premium for the pines' resources: lumber, tar and pitch, which were essential in maintaining seaworthy ships. As timber industries grew, the need to transport goods grew as well. Railroads brought more change to the area with small towns cropping up throughout the county to accommodate extra business. With such an extensive rail history, many historic depots still exist in the area and are open to tour.

Make an appointment to visit the immaculately restored **Union Station Railroad Museum** in Aberdeen, housed in



the historic depot circa 1900, or visit the equally historic depot in downtown Southern Pines. For even more rail history, make the short 30-minute drive to Hamlet, NC, to visit the **National Railroad Museum and Hall of Fame**.



WEYMOUTH WOODS SANDHILLS NATURE PRESERVE

Step outside the museum and the history book and breathe in the lessons at Weymouth Woods Sandhills Nature Preserve. This 900-acre preserve showcases the natural features unique to our region. Here you can walk among longleaf pines, many old enough to bear the scars of the turpentine industry, catch a glimpse of fox squirrel, red-cockaded woodpecker or the Pine Barrens tree frog.

Lessons include how fire plays a key role in our environment and how humans have impacted the ecosystem over the centuries.

THIS IS HORSE COUNTRY

On a scenic drive or bike ride through our horse country, past bucolic horse farms where it's not uncommon to see riders on horseback enjoying the beautiful Southern Pines countryside. You may also spot trainers at work with their horses.

If you like to hitch the trailer and travel with your horse, you'll want to visit the expansive **Walthour-Moss Foundation**, which encompasses 4,000 acres of pristine woodlands. Open from sunrise to sunset, the foundation land is perfect for a ride. Consult their website for a complete list of rules: www.walthour-moss.org

CARRIAGE TOURS

Our area is also known for our classic horse-drawn carriage tours. The sounds of horse hooves clip-clopping down the winding streets of the Village of Pinehurst harkens back to a time when horses were the main source of transportation and things moved at a slower pace.

Climb in for an in-depth and personal history of the area. You'll visit historic properties, hear stories of famous individuals who have visited the area and explore the quaint Village of Pinehurst, which was designed by Frederick Law Olmsted, the same person who designed Biltmore Gardens and New York's Central Park.

Tours depart from The Carolina Hotel or The Magnolia Inn Tuesday through Sunday. The carriage seats four, and tours last approximately half an hour. Call 910-690-4580 for reservations.

ON TRACK FOR FUN

The horsin' around fun continues at the **Pinehurst Harness Track**. This 111-acre equestrian facility serves as a winter training center for standardbred horses. Champion trotters and pacers train on the ½-mile sand/clay track, the ⅜-mile sand/jog track, or the one-mile clay track. The tracks are also available for rent when training is not taking place. Typical events include horse shows, car shows, dog shows and rugby matches. Learn more with a call to 910-295-4446.

Be sure to check out our calendar of events (homeofgolf.com/events) to learn about great local events highlighting horses and carriages. From the nearby Carolina Horse Park Derby Cross and Timberland HDT to the Robbins Farmers Day and Christmas Carriage Parade, our area offers plenty of equestrian fun.



OUR BUGGY CONNECTION

From the mid-1800s to the 1920s, the Tyson & Jones Buggy Company in the nearby town of Carthage produced thousands of carriages. The factory was one of the largest producers in the nation, making central North Carolina a hub of carriage building. At its height in the 1890s, Tyson & Jones was producing 3,000 buggies a year. Each May, a large collection of historic carriages are displayed during the popular Carthage Buggy Festival. Tour the buggies, enjoy other classic modes of transportation and partake in arts, crafts, music and food. The festival is fun for the whole family! Find more information at thebuggyfestival.com



HISTORIC DISTRICTS & NEIGHBORING COMMUNITIES

Each of our districts, towns and villages brings its own history and charm to the table. Experience the freedom of building your own trail and blazing your own path.

HISTORIC ADVENTURES

With the advent of timber and rail industries, our area population grew. Homes and businesses cropped up in large numbers, many of which are still standing and display architectural details not seen in modern structures.

In Aberdeen step back in time at the **Malcolm Blue Farm**, which features an 1825 farmhouse nestled on 7.5 acres. Here you can gain insight into the lives of early pioneers. The authentic furnishings, the windmill, gristmill and water well will give an appreciation for our modern conveniences.

Continue your Aberdeen discoveries at the **Bethesda Church and Cemetery**. Built in the late 1700s, the church still carries the scars of bullets from a Civil War battle. Graves include those of area settlers.

WALKING TOURS

Walk the quaint streets of historic Southern Pines and take in the dozens of original structures throughout the nationally registered historic district. Or, take a step back in time with a self-guided walking tour of the Village of Pinehurst. Today, 32 of the original 38 cottages built in the late 1800s in the Village still stand, making the downtown village a National Historic Landmark.

Visit the Tufts Archives in Pinehurst or the Visitors Center in Southern Pines to pick up a copy of the "Village of Pinehurst: A Historic Walking Tour." This beautiful book offers four carefully planned walking tours, complete with historical tidbits and informational details on the homes and other historic buildings. View original photos, learn of famous people who explored the area and see the original owners of these beautiful cottages.



ANNIE OAKLEY

Famed female sharpshooter Annie Oakley, known for her extreme sharpshooting talent and overall knowledge of shooting, has an incredible tie to the Pinehurst area! After a stint working in Buffalo Bill's Wild West traveling show, "Little Miss Sure Shot" came to live at The Carolina Hotel in Pinehurst in 1915 with her husband, Frank Butler. They both were employed by the hotel with Frank running the skeet range and Annie offering exhibitions and shooting lessons. In 1921, Oakley celebrated her 61st birthday by shooting 100 clay pigeons in rapid succession before a crowd of more than 2,000.

THE FAIR BARN

Take a step back to the country fairs of the 1920s with a visit to The Fair Barn in Pinehurst. The building is the oldest surviving early 20th-century fair exhibition hall in North Carolina and was built in 1917 for the Sandhills Fair.

Recently restored, The Fair Barn is now a bustling community gathering place for exhibitions, receptions, private parties, auctions, seminars, concerts, art and antiques shows, and any other functions requiring a large, flexible space. Call 910-295-0166 for more information.

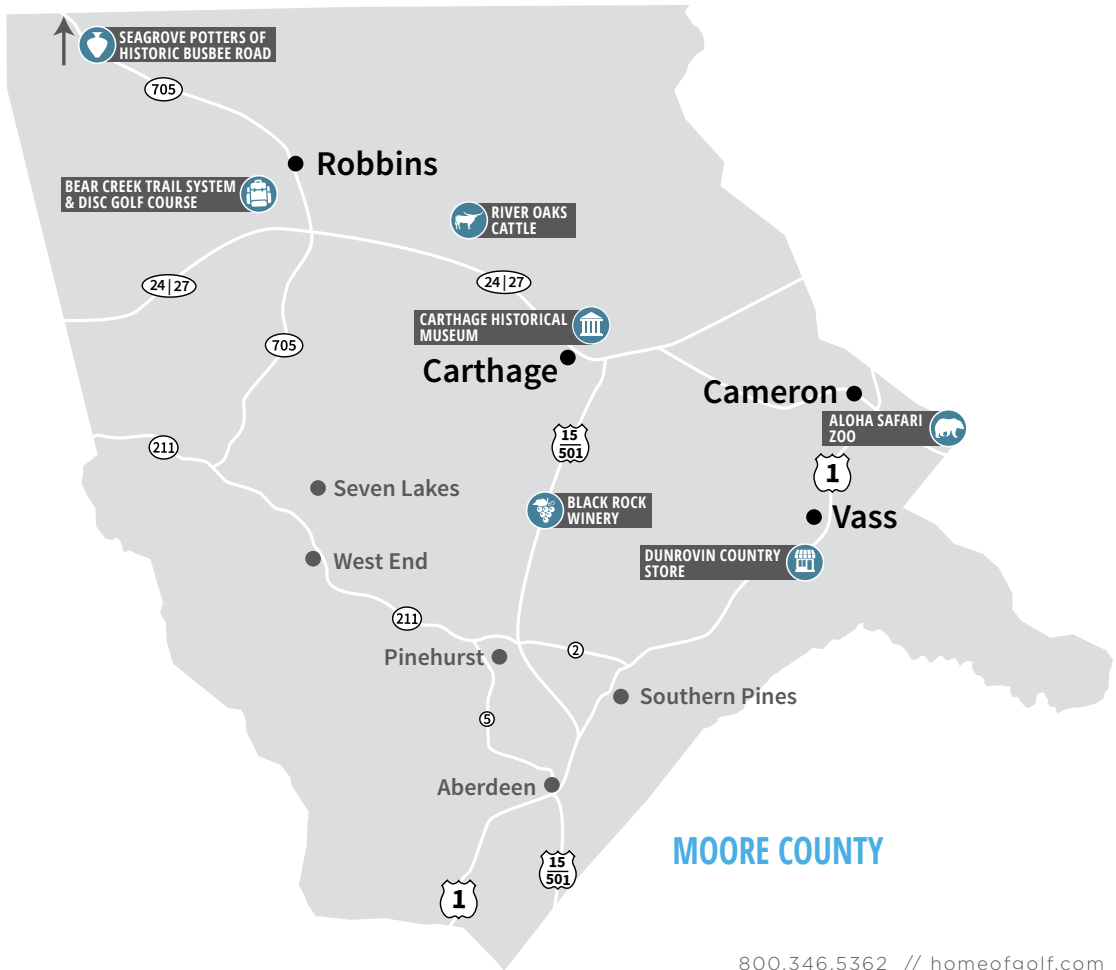


HERITAGE AND HOMETOWN FEEL

MOORE COUNTY

WELCOME TO ROBBINS

Historically, the Town of Robbins was buzzing with activity. Manufacturing plants and textile mills provided a steady economic base. When those businesses closed after economic changes, the town suffered but rallied to find a new path.

Today Robbins is energized and celebrating its history and future. Nowhere is that crossroads more evident than the annual **Robbins Farmers Day**. On a warm August weekend the population of the town swells to more than 30,000 as visitors and residents enjoy getting together.

In Robbins the great outdoors are truly that – great! A hike along the **Bear Creek Trail System** delivers eight miles of trails that wind along the Bear and Cabin Creeks. Four miles are open to bikes.

Stop by the map kiosk at the trail head to pick your loop, distance and difficulty. Another way to get some fresh air is to try your hand at the 18-hole **Bear Creek Disc Golf Course**.

At the **Robbins Village Theatre**, all eyes are looking to the future with plans to revitalize the historic Village Theater and return it to a cultural arts center and meeting place. The transformation will provide a venue for plays, movies, art exhibits, performances and featured speakers.

GREETINGS FROM VASS

Driving along U.S. Highway 1, south of Sanford and north of Southern Pines, you'll spot **Dunrovin Country Store** ahead, and feel like someone turned the clock back to the 1950s. The oldest and largest country store in Moore County is a must-stop for homemade fudge, Amish food, old-fashioned candies and much more. Be sure to save room for a great meal at **Miller's Family Restaurant** or **Valenti's Italian Restaurant & Pizzeria**.



TRADITIONS IN CARTHAGE

Long before our modern cars and trucks were racing down the highways, the buggy was the main mode of transportation in rural America. Many of those buggies were crafted right here in Carthage at the Tyson and Jones Buggy Factory. It's a history that reminds you to slow down and enjoy the small town charm.

Each May the town honors their past with a **buggy festival** that brings in treasured buggies from across the country. And throughout the year you can view exhibits at the **Carthage Historical Museum** which covers more than 200 years of area history.

While you are downtown you'll surely notice the impressive mural commemorating the Tyson and Jones Buggy Factory. A second mural honors WWI pilot James R. McConnell who lived in Carthage. A third mural is underway depicting the tobacco-centric life of our county.

Don't leave town without a little sipping and snacking. The sipping at **Black Rock Winery**, a new winery and the first vinifera vineyard in this area. The snacking at **Aroma Café and Bakery** where the soups and sandwiches are only rivaled by the pies and pastries.



CAMERON: FROM DEWBERRIES TO ANTIQUES

Cameron was once known as the "Dewberry Capital of the World" because of the farming of dewberries. Today, it is the antique capital of the region. Twelve shops are open year-round and each year antiques enthusiasts flock to **two popular festivals**, one the first Saturday in May and the other the first Saturday in October, to browse items from hundreds of dealers.

To visit with animals from A to Z, include a stop at the **Aloha Safari Zoo**. Their collection ranges from the African Crested Porcupine to the Zebra. And those Cameron dewberries... you can learn more about them and try the namesake cobbler at the **Dewberry Deli**.



MOORE TO SEE AND DO

Robbins Farmers Day - August

Harkening back to the days when a buggy ride to town was the highlight of the week, maybe even the month, Robbins Farmers Day traces its beginnings back to 1955 and a simple request for a parade permit. Soon the idea grew and Mr. Curtis Hussey became "The Wagonmaster" with his 1906 covered wagon made by Tyson and Jones Buggy Factory in nearby Carthage. His wife, Mrs. Beulah Hussey, made a new wagon cover every year.

Now the parade attracts more than 30,000 people and includes a 5K Run/Walk, carnival rides, food vendors, live music, fireworks and of course the popular parade of wagons.

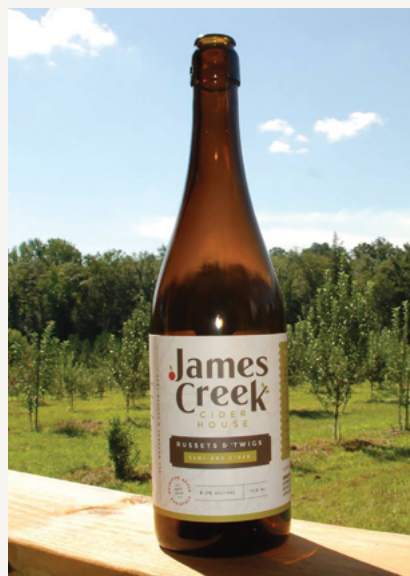

UWHARRIE NATIONAL FOREST

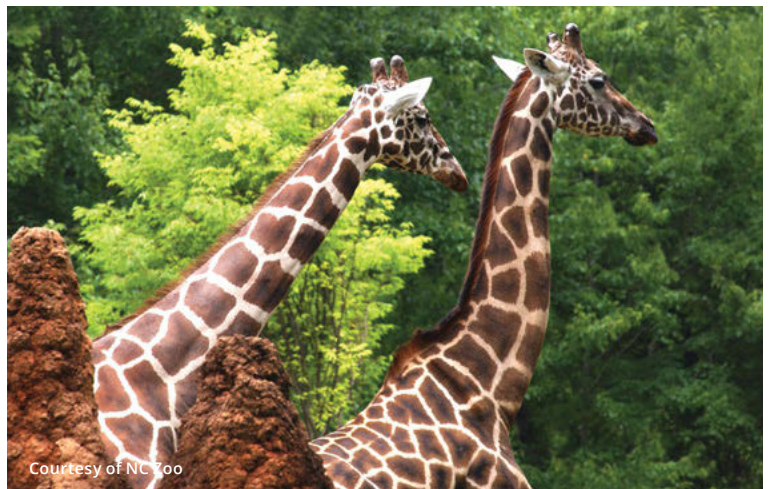

CARTHAGE MURALS

For a culturally stimulating side trip, visit the town of Carthage to see the **Carthage Mural Project**. This unique artistic expression, the work of North Carolina artist Scott Nurkin, adorns the sides of historic downtown buildings.

His mural in homage of the Tyson & Jones Buggy Company graces the side of the Nationwide Insurance building and is an impressive 89 feet wide and 17 feet high. His second work, which honors James R. McConnell, a WWI pilot who lived in Carthage, is located beside Fidelity Bank at 205 Monroe St. And a third mural, depicting the agricultural life of the county, will be completed in 2018.

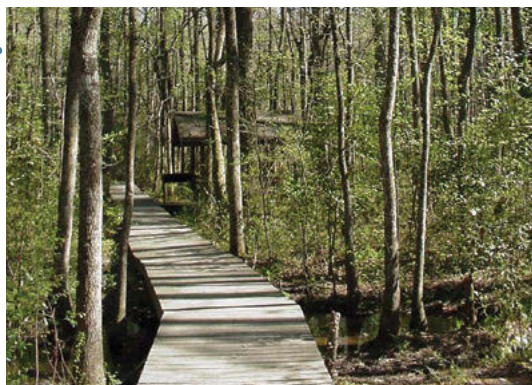
GREENWAY TRAIL SYSTEM

The **Southern Pines Greenway Trail System** winds through the county and connects many parks. One of the parks along the way, **Reservoir Park**, has 12 miles of packed sand trails and two scenic loops. Or, enjoy the Village of Pinehurst's **Rassie Wicker Park** with its three miles of walking trails and a stunning 33-acre arboretum.



TRAILS & PARKS

For longer hikes in hillier settings, try the 21-mile **All-American Trail** that runs adjacent to Fort Bragg, **Weymouth Woods State Park** (home to the insectivorous purple pitcher plant), or the beautiful **Uwharrie National Forest**. A short drive from Moore County, the Uwharrie trails are known for their scenery, constantly-changing terrain and access to streams, creeks and Badin Lake. For an equestrian option, bring your horse to the **Walthour Moss Horse Trail**.
