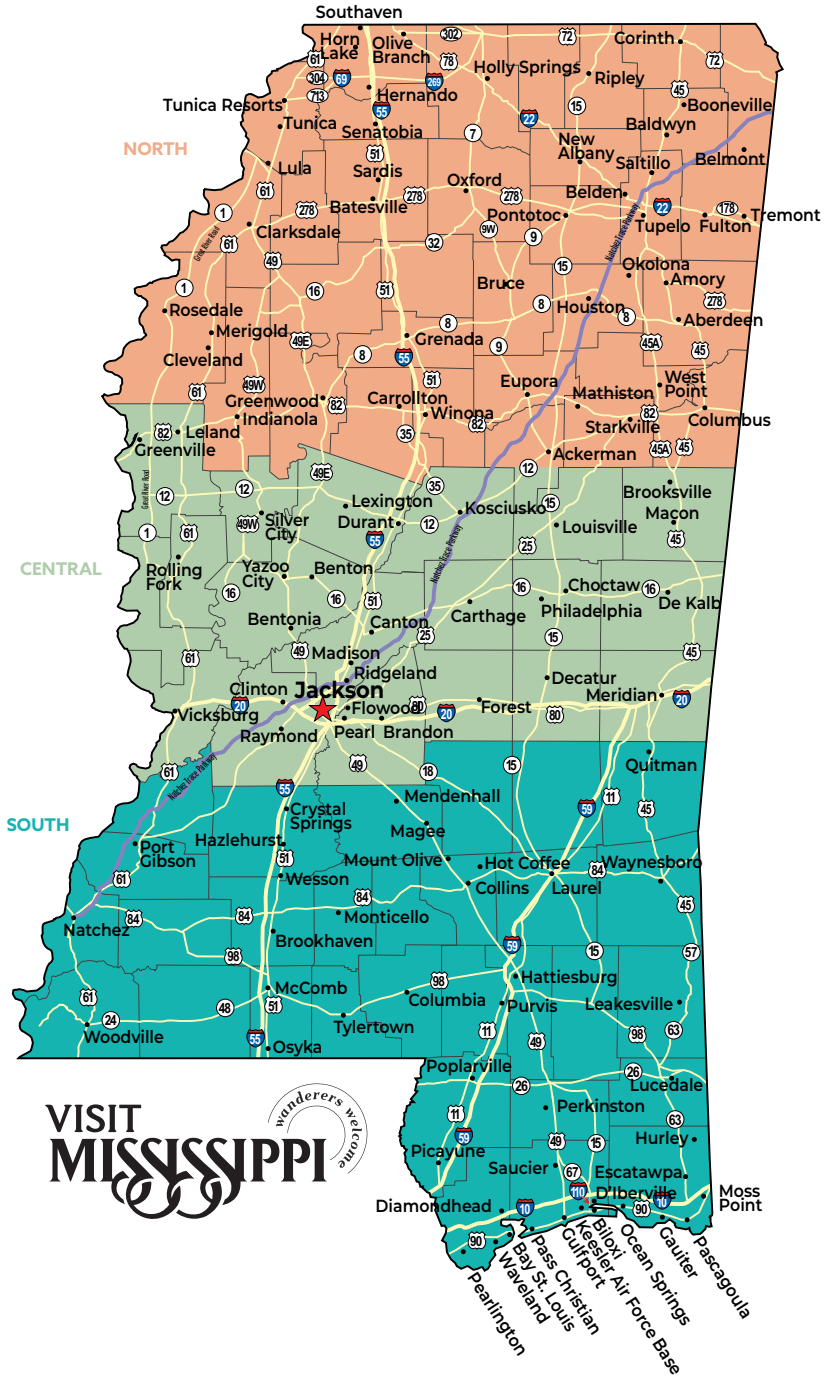

Beyond the music and entertainment in Mississippi, there's unbeatable dining. The state's cuisine defies categorization. In some cases, it defies imagination. From catfish to comeback sauce, from tamales to traditional Southern sweets, from shrimp to slugburgers to sweet potatoes, Mississippi's culinary heritage has something to please every palate. The Magnolia State is home to James Beard award-winning chefs and noted national food writers, as well as some of the best home cooks and out-of-the-way diners anywhere.

In North Mississippi, satisfy your appetite with prime steaks at Mesquite Chophouse in Southaven,

barbecue shrimp at Orleans Bistro in Grenada or the state's best catfish at Taylor Grocery near Oxford.

Central Mississippi is a foody haven with exciting casino eateries and both new and old locales in Jackson. Don't miss Walker's Drive In or the new restaurant at Highball Lanes in Jackson's Fondren entertainment district. The region also features some of the best rooftop bars like 10 South Rooftop Bar & Grill on the Mississippi River in Vicksburg and Missy Sippy Roof Top Bar boasting a beautiful sunset view of downtown Jackson, overlooking The Refuge Golf Course at the Sheraton in Flowood.

The foothills of the Appalachians reach into the northeast corner of Mississippi, creating the highest elevations in the state in the North Region. The rolling countryside makes for challenging courses and the beautiful vistas provide a scenic backdrop, making the golf courses in the region as unique as the topography. The area is singular in its contribution to the explosive growth of rock 'n' roll as a musical genre, as the birthplace of Mississippi's most famous musical legend, Elvis Presley.

The Mississippi Delta, also in the North Region, contains some of the most fertile soil in the world, as evidenced by the verdant green fairways of its exciting golf courses. The region was also fertile ground for the cultivation of America's own original music, making it known worldwide as the birthplace of the blues. Although most of the golf is centered around Tunica, just south of the gaming destination you'll find the world's blues mecca. Clarksdale is home to the historic Delta Blues Museum, the Morgan Freeman-owned Ground Zero Blues Club, numerous Mississippi Blues Trail markers, and the famous Crossroads. Further south, Cleveland is home to the state-of-the-art GRAMMY Museum® Mississippi, showcasing the accolades received by musical Mississippians.

Home to six casinos, Tunica offers many musical and gaming venues, including more than 300 table games and more than 12,000 slots. The culinary options are just as diverse, with selections of barbecue, buffets, diners and steakhouses. Two truly top-notch golf courses in Tunica add another reason to pack your bags and head to the region. River Bend Links features a dunes-laden, open layout, and Tunica National boasts rolling terrain, wide fairways, generous greens and unspoiled surroundings.

Also just south of Memphis, DeSoto County boasts four championship golf courses. They are Cherokee Valley, featuring wide fairways and large greens, plus 11 lakes and 78 bunkers; Timber Truss, with friendly, open fairways, but strategically placed mounds and water; Wedgewood, situated on rolling, scenic terrain and featuring demanding water hazards; and North Creek, which offers strategic, grassy mounds, large, undulating greens and dogleg fairways for a real test. Packaged with local hotels, the courses create an affordable golf vacation with lots of variety.

A short distance southeast of DeSoto County is Kirkwood National Golf Club. This scenic course was named one of *Golf Digest's* top new courses when it opened and has continued to receive great reviews. The course displays dramatic changes in elevation and wooded valleys, with numerous creeks and lakes running throughout. Fully furnished cottages, with living areas and four bedrooms offer convenient lodging right on the golf course.

The Dogwoods Golf Course at Hugh White State Park is located just off Interstate 55 in Grenada. When the course opened, the Dogwoods was ranked the fifth "best new affordable course" in the country by *Golf Digest*. The signature hole here is the par-5, 9th hole. Perched high above the fairway with an incredible view of Grenada Lake, the tee shot is as beautiful as it is intimidating.

The charming college town of Oxford is another great spot to stay and play, boasting restaurants and boutique hotels on its historic town square, and offering three golf courses. The Ole

Golf Mississippi

NORTH REGION

Miss Golf Course offers updated fairway bunkers and greens, making the complex layout a truly modern course; the nine-hole Links Course is perfect for a warm-up round or to settle any lingering bets; and the Jim Fazio-designed Country Club of Oxford is open to member guests and reciprocal privileges.

Old Waverly Golf Club in West Point combines the essence of the Scottish Highlands with a graceful Southern setting. Designed by Bob Cupp and Jerry Pate, it was built on gently rolling terrain. The course is highlighted by the signature 18th hole, a 445-yard par-4 dogleg left with water along the left side and is ranked No. 3 “best in the state” by both *Golf Digest* and *Golfweek*. Most notably, the course hosted the U.S. Women’s Open in 1999.

Gil Hanse designed Old Waverly’s sister course, Mossy Oak. Hanse’s signature minimalist design follows the natural lay of the land. The course is dotted with mature oak trees along open fairways

and slight elevation changes. Upon opening, the course was named the third “best new course” in the country and is currently second “best in state” by *Golf Digest*.

Mossy Oak is located across the street from Old Waverly. The courses partner to increase golf excursions to the eastern side of the state. They each feature on-site, luxurious golf cottages with multiple bedrooms for custom stay-and-play packages and were just named among the “best golf resorts in the southeast” by *Golf Digest*.

The North Region vacation options range from great value golf and juke joint entertainment in small towns to luxurious award-winning golf-centric resorts and high energy casino hotels. The moderate climate and its close proximity to both the Midwest for those driving, and Memphis International Airport, make it one of Mississippi’s most popular and convenient golf destinations.

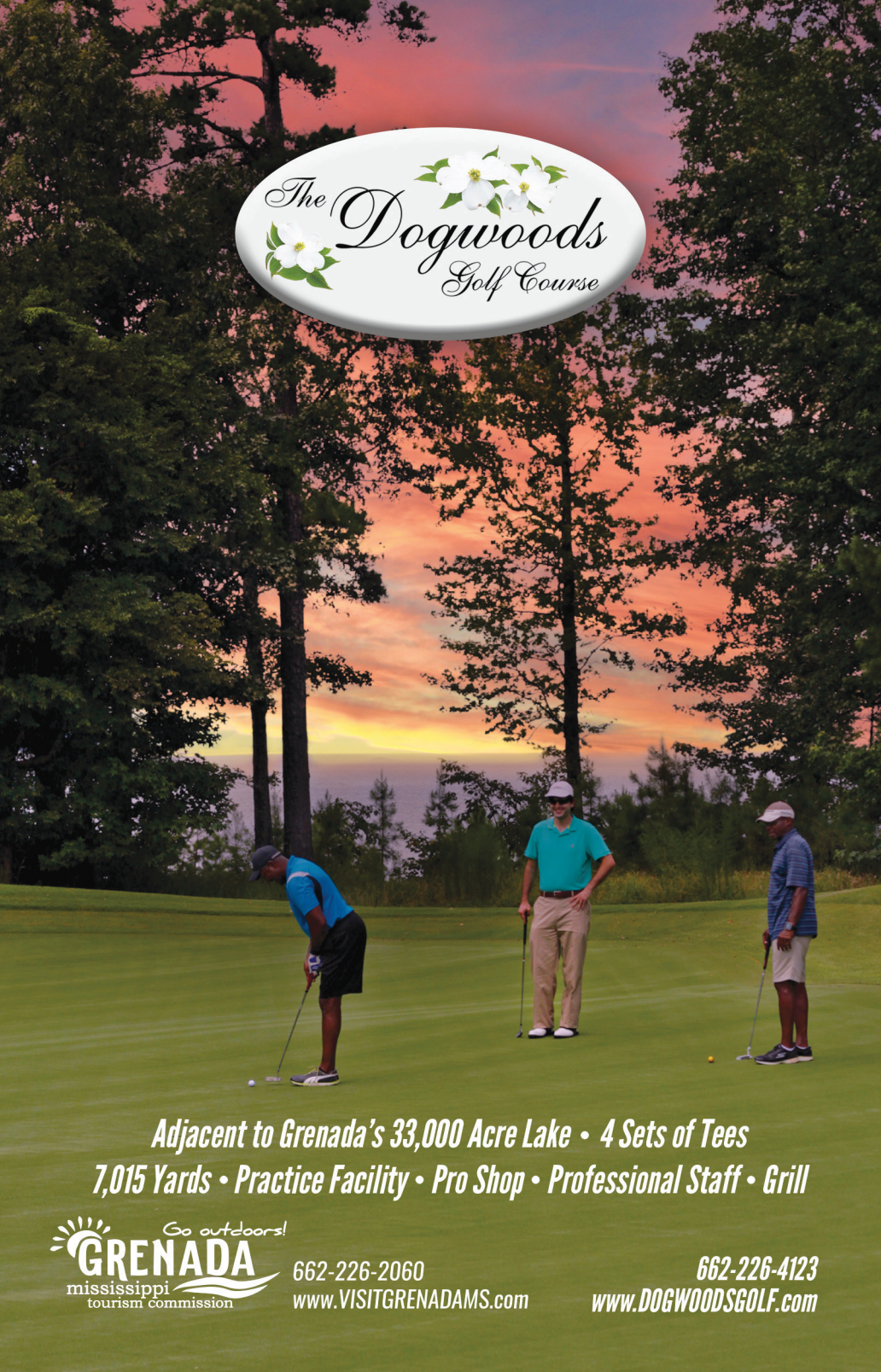

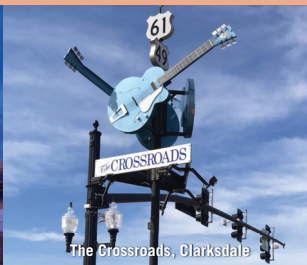

The Magnolia State's Central Region consists of the capital city of Jackson, the historic river town of Vicksburg, and the largest casino resort in the south in the native town of Choctaw. It is a unique blend of modern amenities and historic attractions.

The golf layouts in Central Mississippi range from wide-open flatlands to tight, water-lined fairways – sometimes right on the same course. Professional golfers experience this each year as the metro area hosts some of the top players on the PGA TOUR at the Sanderson Farms Championship, played at The Country Club of Jackson.

The historic river town in the region, Vicksburg, has two unique courses. The Vicksburg Country Club, opened in 1929, has amazing elevational changes for this region and Clear Creek offers a traditional parkland layout. With four riverboat casinos, a national military park and waterfront dining, this town is a unique hotspot.

Following a major renovation, including new routing, greens, bunkers, tees and the widening of playing corridors, The Refuge in the Jackson suburb

of Flowood reopened last year with the addition of a new 220-room Sheraton hotel and conference center. It's located close to the Jackson-Evers International Airport, so a round before takeoff can be a great ending to any visit to the capital city. Managed by Troon®, the course provides a playable layout with three new holes and returning nines, and features stunning views and impeccable course conditions. The hotel itself features 220 modern and comfortable guest rooms, over 25,000 square feet of meeting space, and several places to eat and drink, most notably the rooftop Missy Sippy bar where sunsets over downtown Jackson are spectacular.

Also in metro Jackson, Bay Pointe is well known for its excellent conditioning, indigenous landscaping, and tight, challenging fairways. Patrick Farms is a semi-private facility boasting spacious, well-manicured Bermuda fairways and greens. With lots of nightlife and attractions, the Jackson area makes a great hub for a golf vacation.

An hour east of Jackson in Choctaw is Pearl River Resort. The two courses at the resort's Dancing Rabbit Golf Club, The Azaleas and The Oaks, were built on the ancestral lands of the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians. Each of the 36 holes at Dancing Rabbit bears the distinctive touch of course architects Tom Fazio and Jerry Pate. Both courses receive abundant praise. The Azaleas is currently ranked 33rd on GOLF® magazine's "top 100 courses you can play" list and both courses are in the top ten "best in state" by both *Golfweek* and *Golf Digest*.

Pearl River Resort also offers two high-energy casinos with sportsbook; restaurants ranging from an upscale steakhouse and Southern cafe to a sports bar and coffee shop; two casino hotels; a golfer's inn and unique clubhouse lodging.

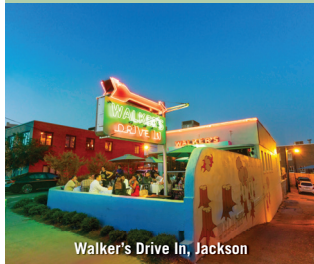

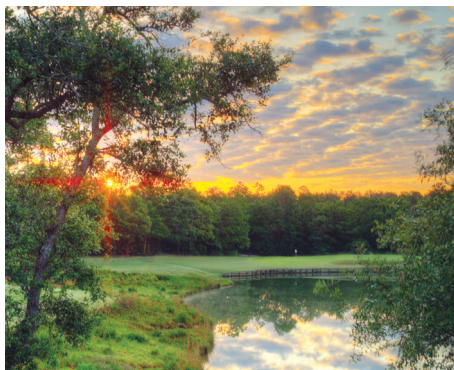

The historic districts of Natchez, Hattiesburg and Laurel showcase charming Victorian and turn-of-the-century mansions. Along the Gulf of Mexico in the Biloxi/Gulfport area lies a chain of glitzy casinos, exciting music venues, beachfront hotels and condos, and one-of-a-kind restaurants. Golfers love the culinary treats in the region that include world-famous tamales, fresh Gulf seafood, Mississippi catfish and succulent barbecue.

Mississippi attracts professional golfers along the coast as well, by hosting a PGA TOUR Champions event each spring.

Natchez is home to two intriguing courses. Beau Pré Country Club is situated on the banks of Second Creek and features a 90-foot clay bluff and rolling terrain. Natchez Golf Club at Duncan Park is a traditional-style course built in 1916 near the historic downtown, where many homes survived the Civil War. This river town is home to an exciting casino, many bed and breakfasts in sprawling mansions, riverfront hotels and a variety of dining and nightlife.

Just east of Natchez, rolling terrain, undulating greens and breathtaking scenery are found at Quail Hollow, located in Percy Quin State Park in McComb. Quail Hollow was designed by well-known architect Arthur Hills. Golf villas providing modern amenities are conveniently located at the state park

to create great value stay-and-play packages.

An hour north of the Mississippi coastline is the college town of Hattiesburg. It has become a real foodie town of late, thanks to restaurant owner and chef, Robert St. John. He's become well known for his creative expressions, both in the kitchen and through the written word. His local restaurants speak for themselves. For golfers visiting the area, Timberton Golf Club is a must play. Designed by Mark McCumber, this outstanding layout plays well for all skill levels.

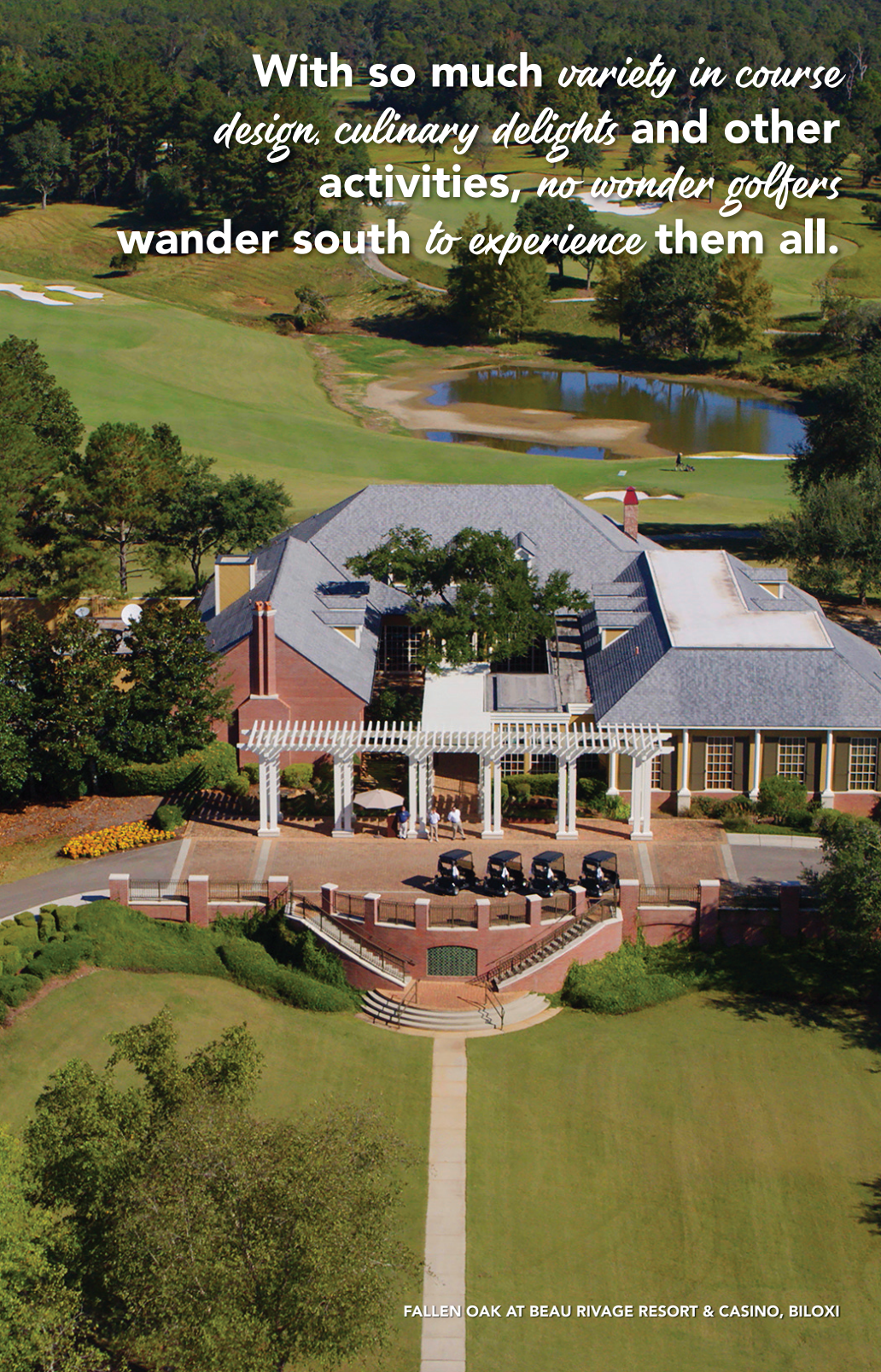
Finally, Coastal Mississippi has been a golfing destination for more than 100 years and is an attractive mix of award-winning golf courses, lively gaming resorts, exciting musical entertainment, one-of-a-kind restaurants, intriguing history and stunning scenery. The Biloxi/Gulfport area is home to both the state's best collection of golf courses and most luxurious casino resorts.

Tom Fazio's contribution is Fallen Oak golf course. Built by MGM as an amenity solely for guests of Biloxi's Beau Rivage Resort & Casino, the course features dramatic bunkers and inviting greens, offering surprising changes in elevation for a coastal course. It has just undergone a \$3.6 million renovation with enhancements to bunkers, bridges, cart paths, and even the already luxurious clubhouse. The course is ranked No. 1 in the state by both *Golf Digest* and *Golfweek* and listed as *Golfweek's* second best casino course in the country behind it's sister Fazio design, Shadow Creek.

Jerry Pate's only coastal design in Mississippi is The Preserve, the home course of Palace Casino Resort. The course has been granted membership into the prestigious Audubon International Signature Program. It's ranked in the top five of both *Golfweek's* and *Golf Digest's* "best in state" rankings and number 13 on *Golfweek's* most recent list of top U.S. casino courses. The Preserve's layout integrates the native surroundings, including cypress swamps, grass prairies and live oak groves.

The Bridges Golf Club in Bay St. Louis is Mississippi's only Arnold Palmer Signature golf

In Pass Christian, The Oaks Golf Club was built by Landmark National of PGA West and Kiawah fame. Strategic bunkering and demanding greens highlight the layout.

The most historic course in the region is Gulf Hills, which opened in 1927 with a recent re-design into an updated 9-hole course along the beautiful Fort Bayou. The adjacent Gulf Hills Hotel & Resort has hosted the likes of Elvis Presley and Al Capone, and is the only waterfront hotel in the quaint, artsy town of Ocean Springs.

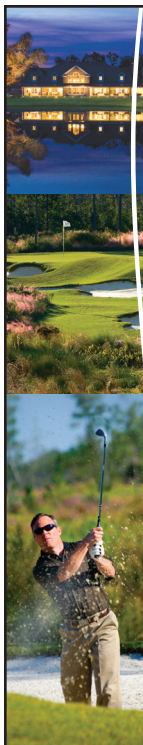

- Day 4 Play Natchez Golf Club at Duncan Park; check out the bars and restaurants Under-the-Hill before enjoying the Magnolia Bluffs Casino
- Day 5 Play Beau Pré Golf Club; have lunch at the award-winning Fat Mama's Tamales in Natchez
