

Our Independent Courses Help Make The Mecca Unique

Sometimes referred to as the independent members of the Gaylord Golf Mecca, the sixsome of golf courses that are not located at our member golf resorts serve as equal and excellent partners in what is a 36-year success story of cooperative golf destination marketing.

Gaylord Golf Club, The Pines at Michaywe,' Lakes of the North Golf Course, Indian River Golf Club, Black Lake Golf Club and The Natural are central to the quality of golf, quantity of golf, multiple price points and community cooperation that are the hallmarks of the Mecca effort. Those successful six courses when added to the five at Treetops Resort, four at Garland Lodge & Golf Resort and two at Otsego Resort add up to 17 member courses in the Mecca.

"We have fabulous resorts that are a part of us, Treetops, Otsego and Garland, which helps us offer great variety and answer the needs of any and all golfers. But we are more than that because of all our independent members add and I think that makes us unique," said Paul Beachnau, executive director of the Gaylord Golf Mecca since its inception.

"Our independent courses are every bit as high quality and maintain the same lofty standards as our resort members. It's what I call one plus one makes three or added value. We are a bonified golf community that offers the same quality standards across the board. You can take any one of our independent courses and compare them to resort properties anywhere else and they offer as good or most of the time a better golf experience."

Independent or resort, Beachnau's mantra is "a rising tide raises all ships. It's the power of working together, which is what the Mecca does best," he said. "In the case of our independent courses, it's especially important they work together but also with our 21 lodging partners."

The lodging partners are where golf packaging of groups for the independent courses often starts. Golfers pick their lodging choice in the area, which can go from shiny new hotel rooms to rustic cabins and then pick the golf courses they want to play. The lodging partners will then aid in securing lodging and tee times. The golfer shows up and plays. The Mecca is all about finding a fresh fit for the golfer. Here's an overview of the Mecca independents.







Gaylord Golf Club

JT Aude, the head golf professional at Gaylord Golf Club, said the lodging partner involvement is tried and true in the Mecca.

"It's worked seamlessly for us for years, especially with the repeat business, and I tell people who call sometimes because they have heard of us to book through a lodging partner because then they can play other Mecca courses too," he said.

"We work together. We don't expect them to play our course three straight days or whatever. They can if they want – some people love our smooth, perfect greens here and can play it every day – but they can do so much more because we are part of the Mecca."



Lakes of the North Golf Course

Rob Diroff, the head PGA golf professional at Lakes of the North Golf Course, said being part of the Mecca allows him to reach his goals for the facility, "I want as many people as possible to play here, experience our course, see our community and find that get-away-from-it-all feeling."

Lakes of the North, at Diroff's urging, rejoined the Gaylord Golf Mecca cooperative marketing group a few years ago. The course was a founding Mecca member over 35 years ago.

"Being part of the Mecca has been fantastic for us," he said. "We saw results instantly when we re-joined in 2020. There was an almost instant uptick in rounds played, and we continue to get new visitors each season from other places coming to play golf here because of our tie to the Mecca."



The Pines at Michaywé

Judy Mason, head golf professional at The Pines at Michaywé, said being part of the Mecca helps keep The Pines a vibrant golf property.

"We have this wonderful golf course a little bit off the beaten track out here in Michaywe," which is essentially a large residential community," she said. "When we market with the Mecca though, we are also a part of this wonderful destination for golfers. With our partners we offer a unique group of courses, a wide variety of experiences and a great variety of pricing. The Pines is a parkland style course, traditional and yet with the many tee options we have, anybody any age and any skill level can play, be challenged and enjoy."

Indian River Golf Club

Corey Crowell, a PGA professional and the general manager at Indian River Golf Club, loves the history showcased at the course that takes the name of the community where it resides some 25 miles north of Gaylord.

The original nine holes were first built in the 1920s by Wilfrid Reid, a legendary member of the Michigan Golf Hall of Fame, and Warner Bowen added the other nine in the 1980s. When Corey came to Indian River, he prompted the public/private facility to join the Gaylord Golf Mecca marketing cooperative.

"It only made sense," he said. "The Gaylord area has built this amazing reputation as *the* place for golf, so we needed to get the word out. It all made sense. Being part of the Mecca has been a win-win. They let people know about us, and we added a classic style course to their great collection of courses."

The Natural

Kevin Henley, the general manager at The Natural, considers the course one of the independents in the Mecca even though it is on the Beaver Creek Resort property.

"We're operated that way, we are the only course on this property and we're the only course in the Mecca that doesn't have membership categories," he said. "We work with all the partners in the Mecca and by being part of it, we find new golfers to discover us."

The Jerry Matthews-designed course west of Otsego Lake fits all the descriptions of pure Northern Michigan golf—tree-lined, visually appealing, playable, enjoyable, isolated, and a sanctuary for wildlife.

"We offer a little something different, all the members offer something different and that is part of what makes the Mecca work," he said.

The Resort Trio

We'd be remiss if we didn't mention the trio of successful golf resorts that account for 11 of the 17 golf courses that make up the Mecca.

Treetops Resort is home to five fabulous courses, including legendary architect Robert Trent Jones, Sr.'s the Masterpiece.


Garland Lodge & Golf Resort boasts four immaculately conditioned courses that all originate from one convenient clubhouse.

GOLF CLUB

Black Lake Golf Club

Black Lake Golf Club is an 18-hole course designed by nationallyacclaimed architect, Rees Jones, known for his restoration work on many U.S. Open courses. Jones utilized every feature found on the property—from cranberry bogs to a small sand quarry—to produce what may be his most charming design yet. Black Lake has received many national awards and rankings. In 2012/13, Golf Digest awarded Black Lake #69 on its prestigious list of "America's 100 Greatest Public Courses." Golf Digest also ranked Black Lake as the #9 "Best Value" from the Top 100 list.

Always in pristine condition, Black Lake is a championship design that offers golfers of all abilities an enjoyable round of golf.

From Gaylord, take I-75 N to Exit 310 Indian River, take M-68 east, turn left and head north on F-05 (Black River Road) to entrance on left side.

GaylordGolf Club

Gaylord Golf Club is one of Northern Michigan's oldest clubs. Established in 1924, the club moved to its new location just west of Gaylord in 1975.

The course meanders through hills and hardwoods, and features private club conditions. Unlike today's modern courses, which take more time to play, Gaylord Golf Club is a classic parkland design.

You'll find close proximity from greens to tees and a variety of holes designed to allow players to use every club in their bag.

The course features four sets of tees, making it playable for all abilities.

GARLAND LODGE & GOLF RESORT Fountains

Garland's newest course opened in 1995. It experienced a redesign in 2010 by Michael Benkusky whose work includes the famed Canyata Golf Club in Marshall, Illinois.

Do not let the length fool you strategy is required to approach shots on the very undulating green complexes.

Featuring bent grass from tee to green, Fountains was ranked as the number 12 course in Michigan by Golf Advisor in 2017.

Immaculately conditioned, this course offers a unique 6-6-6 design, with several par 5's offering dramatic risk and reward opportunities.

GARLAND LODGE & GOLF RESORT Monarch

Garland's longest course is a true championship test of golf. Very large green complexes and wide fairways allow you to "grip it and rip it" although the northern Michigan forest lurks not far off.

Monarch is a traditional layout with an excellent blend of length and risk and reward holes.

Greens are well bunkered on most holes. There is also a great mix of left and right doglegs. Monarch is used for most member championship tournaments.

GARLAND LODGE & GOLF RESORT Reflections

Reflections may be the shortest of Garland's four courses, but do not let length fool you. Routed through a northern Michigan hardwood forest, Reflections requires accuracy off the tee.

Par 5's require strategic thought before your tee shot for best placement of either going for the green or laying up. Playing during September and October offers a beautiful ride through the fall colors of Michigan.

Reflections also features six par 3's, 4's and 5's. Several of the Par 3 holes are iconic. Green complexes are well bunkered with subtle undulations



GARLAND LODGE & GOLF RESORT Swampfire

With water visible on 15 of 18 holes, Swampfire is designed to visually intimidate the player, although on many holes water doesn't come into play.

Par 5's require strategy on the second shot. Offering a unique design, Swampfire features five Par 3's and 5's to go with 8 Par 4's. Several Par 4's offer excellent risk and reward opportunities.

You won't find many tee complexes like number 5 with its horseshoe shape around a pond and offering shots from 100 to 180 yards from a variety of angles.

Generous fairways offer a great blend of both left and right doglegs and green complexes again require study with very subtle breaks.

Indian River Golf Club

Indian River Golf Club was established in 1922. Through the years several changes and improvements have been made, but some things have not changed such as the Club's long-standing pride in ownership and our friendly professional staff. Golf Digest has rated Indian River Golf Club as one of the best places to play in Northern Michigan. The course is always in excellent shape, it is a challenging, yet walkable layout with a variety of tees for all levels of golfer. The course also offers plenty of diversity with elevation changes, water, tree-lined fairways and a few fairways that are wide open.

The Natural

Jerry Matthews, renowned for creating courses that reflect the environment's tranquil beauty, designed The Natural. The Natural winds through elevated forested terrain around some of the most scenic wetlands found in Northern Michigan.

OTSEGO RESORT The Classic

TREETOPS RESORT Tradition

Links-style of a Grand Design

The Tradition, Rick Smith's walking course, pays homage to golf's origin, and is well named as it features traditional wooden pins, rakes and pennant flags.

The links-style layout takes advantage of high ridges and hilltops, providing some sloping while allowing for a spectacular walk.

The Tradition is a great challenge for all players, including beginners, families and junior golfers. In fact, our popular PGA Junior League program plays their matches each week on this course.

In 2022, the Tradition had over 800 trees removed along with other improvements to more closely align with the inland links-style course that was intended.

TREETOPS RESORT Masterpiece

Robert Trent Jones Senior's **Crowning Glory**

Robert Trent Jones, Sr.'s final design in Michigan is truly a masterpiece. People travel from all over the U.S. to check this course off their list. In his own words, Jones claimed it his crowning glory. The course is located at the headwaters of the Pigeon River and takes full advantage of natural valleys, ravines and broad plains. The signature 6th hole features a 120' vertical drop and a panoramic view of the Pigeon River Valley. Only about one well-hit drive away from the new chalets.



The Masterpiece has one of the highest slope ratings in the Midwest. Hole six is where Robert Trent Jones, Sr. coined the name Treetops. One look from the tee box and you'll see why!

Signature has been rated a Top 50 Course for Women and ranked in the country's Top 100 by Golfweek.

After putting out on number 18 and driving back towards the clubhouse, pay attention to the memorial for Rick Smith's dog "DIVOT." Rumor has it if you leave the worst ball in your bag at his memorial site to pay homage, you'll have good luck in your next round.

1. OTSEGO BY THE NUMBERS

- 1,500 FEET: Peak elevation in Otsego County—that's more than 900 feet above lakes Michigan and Huron, meaning all the rain that hits the ground here (or emerges from springs) flows down and away into Northern Michigan's many rivers.
- 120 FEET: Maximum depth of Heart Lake, near Waters, only 60 acres in size but is the county's deepest, making it an ideal fishery for rainbow trout and smelt.
- 3.1 MILLION: Number of walleye fry stocked in Otsego Lake in 2017. Another combined 1 million were planted in 2016 and 2018.
- 33: Number of Master Angler catches reported in Otsego County for 2018, including a 45-inch pike speared on Opal Lake, a 31.25-inch walleye caught on Otsego Lake, and a 15.5-inch brook trout caught on Ford Lake, along with numerous monster bass and panfish.
- 2. CATCH A LIVING FOSSIL There's no doubt Otsego Lake is home to monsters but it is one of only a handful of places in Michigan where you can catch a true living fossil: the lake sturgeon. Started in the mid-1980s, the lake's sturgeon stocking program began as an experiment to study how fast sturgeon could grow in an inland environment. The fingerling fish grew fast,

hitting 40 inches and beyond in just a dozen years. Since then, small plantings of excess fish from the Black River hatchery in Onaway have helped sustain this special fishery. The season runs July 16 to March 15.

3. GO SMALL FOR BIG FISH You don't need to stick to the big water to catch monsters. When late-summer sun drives up water temps, trout are forced to find cooler, shaded water in upstream stretches. Even in spots where a sprightly angler can leap the river in a single bound, monster brookies, browns and rainbows can lurk in undercut banks or among submerged timber. Wear dark clothing and be sneaky in your approach, and you might just be rewarded with a trophy.

4. FISH EARLY OR LATE FOR BEST ODDS

Gaylord's glorious summer days bring out waterskiers, wave runners and boaters which can make midday waters noisy and choppy. Additionally, direct sun sends fish deeper where they hunker down and wait until things cool off. Your best odds for good fishing comes early morning and late evening—about the first 90 minutes after sunup and before sunset. Take advantage of light morning or evening winds to cast topwater plugs or surface flies for bass and panfish, or to bobber fish without interference from boat wake. This way, you'll be on your way off the lake with your limit of fish before the first speedboat shows up!

POST-GREEN GROG WHAT'S BREWING IN GAYLORD By Lynda Wheatley 22 | NORTHERN MICHIGAN GOLFER

If you're lucky enough to find yourself swinging some stick in the Gaylord Golf Mecca, we suggest you cap off your round like so many do: with a toast and a tasting (multiple tastings recommended) of its hometown-brewed beer. Two convivial craft breweries sit within the city limits—one on Main Street; the other a 1,500-yard dogleg to the right—both equally adept at quickly seating, feeding, and pouring pints aplenty for beleaguered twosomes, foursomes, and groups far larger.

Owners Angielena and Nate Muellenberg might have given a nod to the area's extraordinary snowfall when naming their brewpub, but you'll find their downtown spot a cozy bright spot no matter the season. A giant glass garage-style door lets in the sun and, when the weather warms, opens wide to the northern air.

Revelers can choose from 16 ways to wet their whistle (primarily beer, but a couple house ciders, meads, and/ or wines round out the offerings). Expect a breadth of beers for all tastes and seasons, from solid standards like Floralei, a light blonde ale that drinks like a pilsner, recently offered alongside an autumnal Pumpkin Brown, to unexpected innovators like Lav You Long Time, an herb-y beer made with local honey and lavender.

Snowbelt's menu embraces the experimental, too—turning the mandatory drinking partners (tots, sandwiches, salads, pizza) into something-for-everyone indulgences. Two worth writing home about: a Grown-up Grilled Cheese so spicy it comes with a no-refund warning, and the Brew-Ben, featuring savory corned beef and beer-soaked sauerkraut.

Don't let the soaring timber-trussed ceiling, chandeliers, or two-story window into Big Buck Brewery's stainless brewing sanctum intimidate you; hat hair and weird tan lines are welcome at the massive bar or in the main dining hall. Thanks to new owners Cathy and Shawn Smalley, who overhauled the I-75-adjacent icon, great service, great food, and great beer are the norm.

The brewery delivers more than a dozen traditional, delicious beers to the taps — German and English ales, Belgian and American wheats, a pale ale, a brown ale, IPAs, and more — and you can sample up to five at a time, from a bona fide buck rack.

If you've got the room, Big Buck makes a mega menu by merging Alpen/Northern mainstays with some outstanding dishes you wouldn't expect to see served under a mounted deer head. Among our favorites: potato and cheese pierogies (sourced from Srodek's in Hamtramck!) and topped with bacon, onion, and melted cheddar jack; 24-hour brined in-house smoked wings with signature sauce; and any pizza — each crust is made even better with Big Buck's Red Bird Ale — that slides out of the eatery's brick pizza oven.




