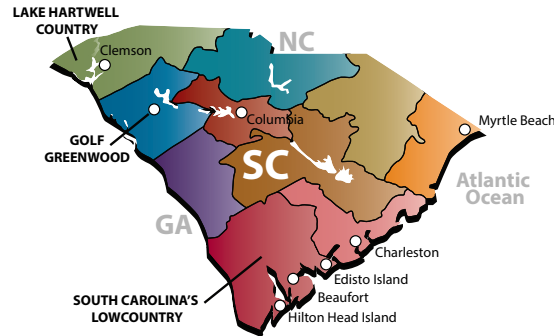
HIDDEN GEMS FOR THE AVID GOLFER

There are many great golf destinations all around South Carolina. From the mountains to the coast and the pristine lakes in between, these unique, "undiscovered" locales are beckoning golfers to try something different in the Palmetto State. South Carolina's Lowcountry covers the most southern coastline and the small towns along and west of I-95 just north of Georgia. 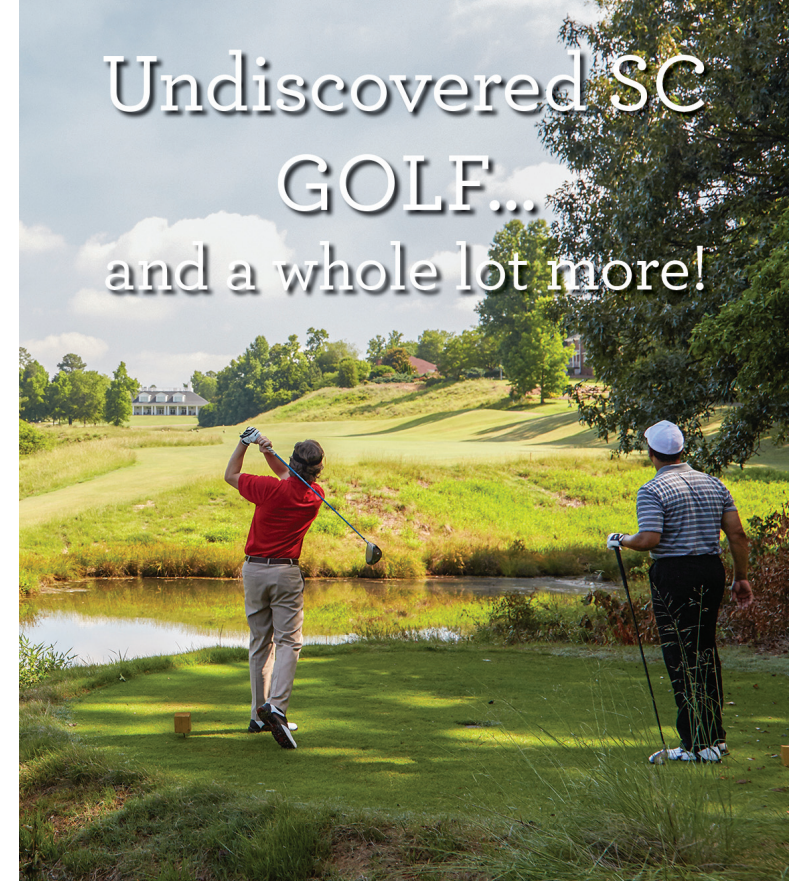

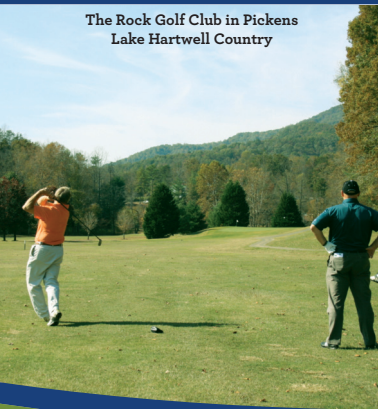

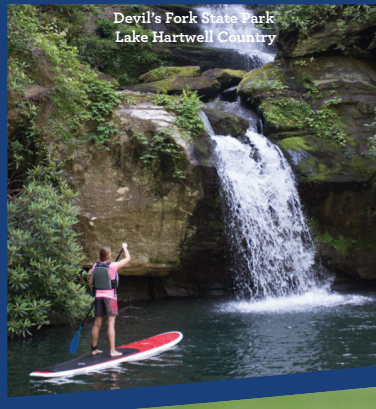

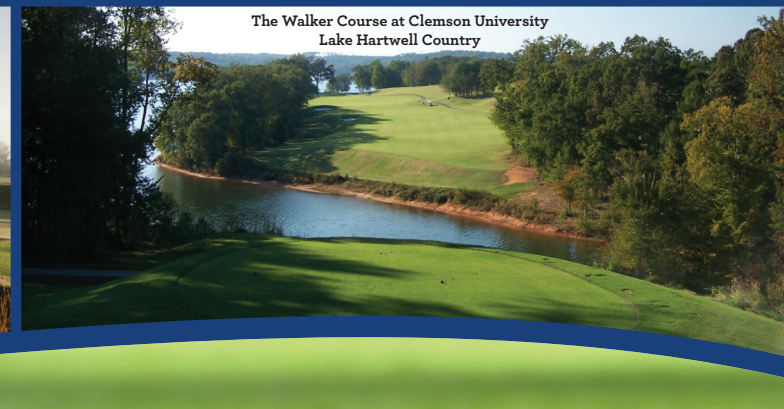
